



# 2017 Brown Jug Race Notice of Race



**Labor Day - Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup>**

**Eligibility:** Any sailboat not over 25 feet that sails on Irondequoit Bay.

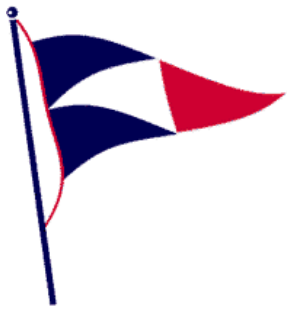
**Registration:** Boats must register at the Rochester Canoe Club or the Newport Yacht Club by 12:00 noon on September 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Checking In:** All participants must hail their sail number to the committee boat and receive acknowledgment of their hail prior to their start.

**Starting Sequence:** Horns will be sounded in 5:00 minute intervals to indicate Warnings and Starts. A flag will be dropped one minute prior to the next signal (except for the first Warning). All boats are asked to keep clear of the starting line until their start.  
*Time of day is approximate.*

**Course:** The course will be a triangle sailed on Irondequoit Bay. The starting line will be in front of the Rochester Canoe Club. The line will be between a yellow flag displayed on the committee boat and a yellow tetrahedron. Marks of the course will be large orange tetrahedrons. The Opti course will use yellow tetrahedrons and will be considerably shorter in length. Buoys shall be left to port. M1 displayed on the side of the committee boat will indicate 1 time around. M2 will indicate 2 times around.

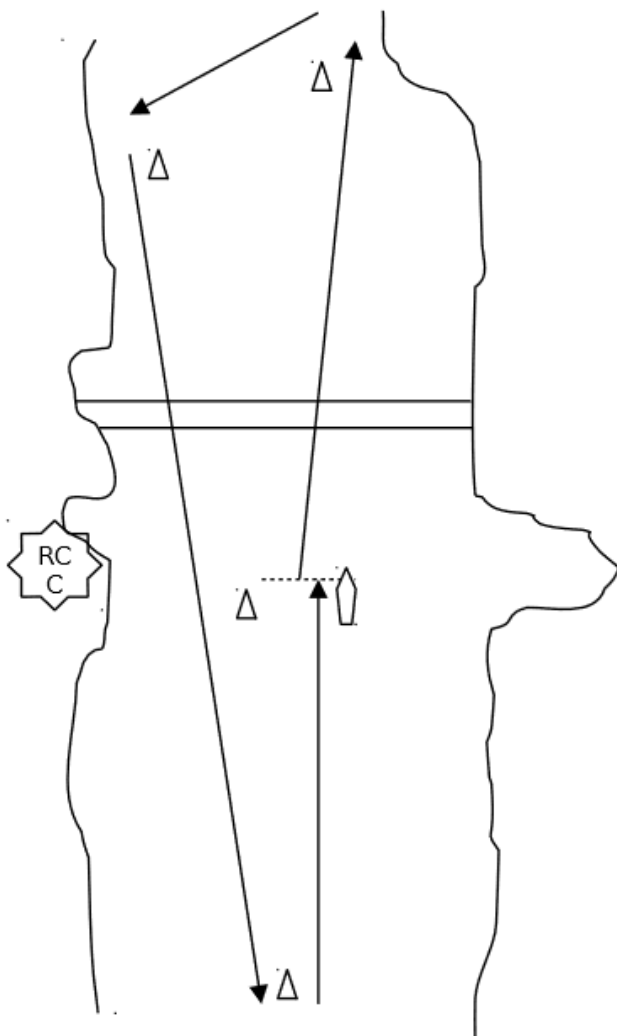
**Lifejackets:** The "Z" flag will be flown to indicate that all participants must wear a USCG approved PFD while racing. Participants not wearing PFDs will **not** be eligible for awards.

**Spinnakers:** No spinnakers are allowed. Spinnaker poles may be used with jibs.

**Awards:** Perpetual jugs and keeper trophies will be awarded at the Rochester Canoe Club after the racing.
