# Safe Boating Certification

RCC adult members are asked to support the running of weekly races at least once per year. Supporting races potentially entails operating a small motorboat (Boston Whaler). With the passage of Brianna’s law in New York State, eventually any person may be required to complete an approved boating safety course in order to operate a mark set boat. All operators of motorized vessels, regardless of age, will need a boating safety certificate by January 1, 2025. The phasing-in of this law is summarized below:

Born on or after	Year certification is required
January 1, 1993	2020
January 1, 1988	2022
January 1, 1983	2023
January 1, 1978	2024

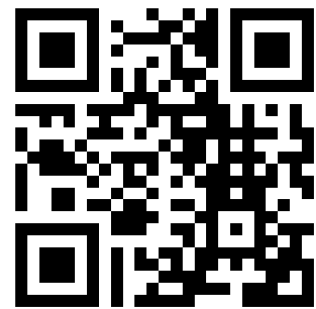
