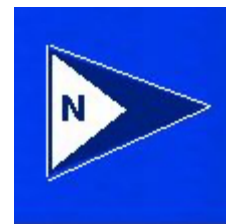




**2021 Brown Jug Regatta  
Labor Day-September 6th  
Newport Yacht Club  
Rochester Canoe Club**



- Eligibility:** Any sailboat not over 25 feet that regularly sails on Irondequoit Bay.
- Registration:** Boats must register at either the Rochester Canoe Club or the Newport Yacht Club by 12 noon on September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- Checking In:** All participants must sail by the stern of the committee boat and hail their sail number to the committee boat prior to their start.
- Start Sequence:** Flags will be raised with one horn sounded in 5:00 minute intervals. A flag will be dropped one minute prior to the next signal. All boats are asked to keep clear of the starting line until their Warning. The Warning for the Cruising Fleet is scheduled for 12:55pm. Any postponement or the first start will delay all starts, but once the sequence begins there will be no further postponements.

- Course:** The course will be a triangle sailed on Irondequoit Bay with the Start/Finish in the middle of the first leg. The starting line will be in front of the Newport Yacht Club. The line will be between a yellow flag displayed on the committee boat and an orange ball. Marks of the course will be orange tetrahedrons. The Opti course will use orange balls and will be considerably shorter in length. Buoys shall be left to port. W1 displayed on the side of the committee boat will indicate 1 time around. W2 will indicate 2 times around. See diagrams on the back. A wide offset mark at the weather mark is likely.
- Lifejackets:** If the "Y" flag is raised with a horn at any time prior to or during racing, it indicates that all participants must wear a USCG approved PFD while racing. If "Y" is raised, then any participants not wearing PFD's will not be eligible for awards. Those 12 years of age and under are required to wear a life jacket whether or not "Y" is flown.
- Spinnakers:** No spinnakers are allowed. Spinnaker poles may be used with jibs.
- Awards:** Perpetual jugs and keeper trophies will be awarded at the Newport Yacht Club after the racing. Please join us for free beer and soda approximately 1 hour after the racing completes!

**W2** - Twice around with windward finish

**W1** - Once around with windward finish

If east, northeast, north, or northwest wind

If west, southwest, south, or southeast wind
