# Notice of Race (NoR)

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The rules and bylaws of the Thistle Class Association (TCA) will apply.
- 1.3 RRS 40.1 shall be in effect. Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- 1.4 Appendix V, Alternative Penalties will be in effect.
- 1.5 RRS A4 and A5 are amended to add: A boat that has not met the definition of *start* five minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS).
- 1.6 RRS 35 is amended to add: Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes of the first boat to finish will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE).
- 1.7 RRS A4 is amended to add: The score for TLE is 2 points more than the number of boats that finished within the time limit.
- 1.8 The US SAILING prescriptions to RRS 88.2, 60.3, 61.4, 67, 70.5(a), 76.1 and Appendix R will apply and are contained in their entirety at:

## 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available at registration.

# 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to all registered boats of the Thistle class that possess a valid measurement certificate.
- 3.2 Current membership in the Thistle Class Association is required for all skippers in the event.
- 3.3 Notify Regatta Coordinator if you plan on attending to facilitate head counts
- 3.4 Registration will be on site and will open at 8:00am on September 9, 2023
- 3.5 Cash or Checks made out to "Rochester Canoe Club" will be accepted. An entry is not complete until payment has been received.
- 3.6 This event is a regatta for the 2023 Thistle Class East Coast Fall Series.

### 4 COMMUNICATION

- 4.1 The official notice board will be on the south wall of the RCC clubhouse interior.
- 4.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 4.3 From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of each day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

### 5 FEES

5.1 Entry fee is \$100. The registration fee includes (for three team members): on Saturday: beverages, light breakfast, lunch, hors d'oeuvres & dinner, and on Sunday: light breakfast

and after sailing, any leftovers from Saturday lunch and dinner.

- 5.2 Please bring your own reusable water bottles. Reusable cups are strongly encouraged for use on shore. Bottled water will not be provided.
- 5.3 Additional Fees for family members and guests
  - 5.3.1 Saturday dinners and dessert may be purchased for \$15 at Registration. Meat and vegetarian options will be provided.
  - 5.3.2 Additional lunches may be purchased for \$5 each at Registration. This includes Saturday lunch as well as Saturday and Sunday breakfasts and beverages.

Multiple races are planned to be sailed
On Sunday, no warning signal will be made after 1400 hours.

# 7 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1 Boats and equipment must be compliant with current TCA rules.
- 7.2 Boats may be inspected at any time during the event for measurement and safety compliance.

### 8 VENUE

- 8.1 The regatta will be sailed from the Rochester Canoe Club on the waters of Irondequoit Bay or Lake Ontario.
- 8.2 Anticipate being towed to Lake Ontario if necessary.

# 9 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be specified in the SIs. The courses will be windward – leeward, triangles, or combinations thereof.

#### 10 SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply. One race will constitute a series. No race scores will be excluded.

# 11 Sailors of the Sea Regatta

11.1 This will be a Clean Regatta under the guidelines of Sailors for the Sea

## 12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk; See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, illness,

disease or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 13 INSURANCE

The organizing authority recommends that each competitor shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

14.2 Other awards may be given at the discretion of the Regatta Coordinators.
